

COVIDSafe information

To ensure the health and safety of delegates, speakers, and staff onsite, we have prepared a list of COVIDsafe practices to help us deliver an enjoyable experience for all. We encourage delegates to note how they can assist us in delivering a COVIDsafe experience when attending in-person.

What the college is doing:

- Encouraging delegates to maintain good hand hygiene and provide necessary supplies such as hand sanitiser.
- Providing masks for delegates and encouraging them to be worn unless eating or drinking.
- Encouraging delegates to maintain social distancing.
- Offering in-person and virtual attendance options.
- Ensuring microphones and other AV equipment are sanitised between use.
- Making plenary session recordings available for 12 months post the meeting for delegates to watch OnDemand.

What the meeting venue is doing:

- Maintaining regular cleaning standards.
- Providing hand sanitiser around the function space and catering station.
- Directing delegates around catering stations to avoid crowding.
- Regularly changing serving utensils for meal breaks.
- Socially distanced seating arrangements.

What you can do as a delegate:

- Ensure you are fully vaccinated and boosted against COVID-19.
- Bring your own N95 or surgical mask with you and ensure you wear it unless eating or drinking. Spare disposable masks will be available at the registration desk onsite.
- Maintain good hand hygiene.
- Maintain social distancing onsite.
- If you do become unwell during the event, ensure that you isolate and get tested for COVID-19. If travelling from interstate or overseas, we encourage you to bring some rapid antigen tests with you as a precaution. Pullman and Mercure King George Square have advised if delegates do test positive to COVID-19, delegates staying inhouse can isolate in their hotel room and access room service and other required services. The hotels request delegates advise the Manager on Duty (contactable via Front Office and available 24 hours).
- Advise the organiser if you do test positive for COVID-19.
