The convenors would like to acknowledge the traditional custodians of the land on which we hold this meeting: the Wurundjeri people. **Naarm encompasses the traditional lands of the Kulin Nation. The Kulin Nation is a collection of five Aborigina nations: the Wurundieri. Boonwurruna. Wathaurruna. Taunauruna and Dia Dia Wurruna.

As the name Naarm is being translated from verbal language, Naarm can be spelled several ways (including Nairm or Narrm) and is used by the Wojwurrung and Boonwurrung language groups of the Central Kulin Nation
