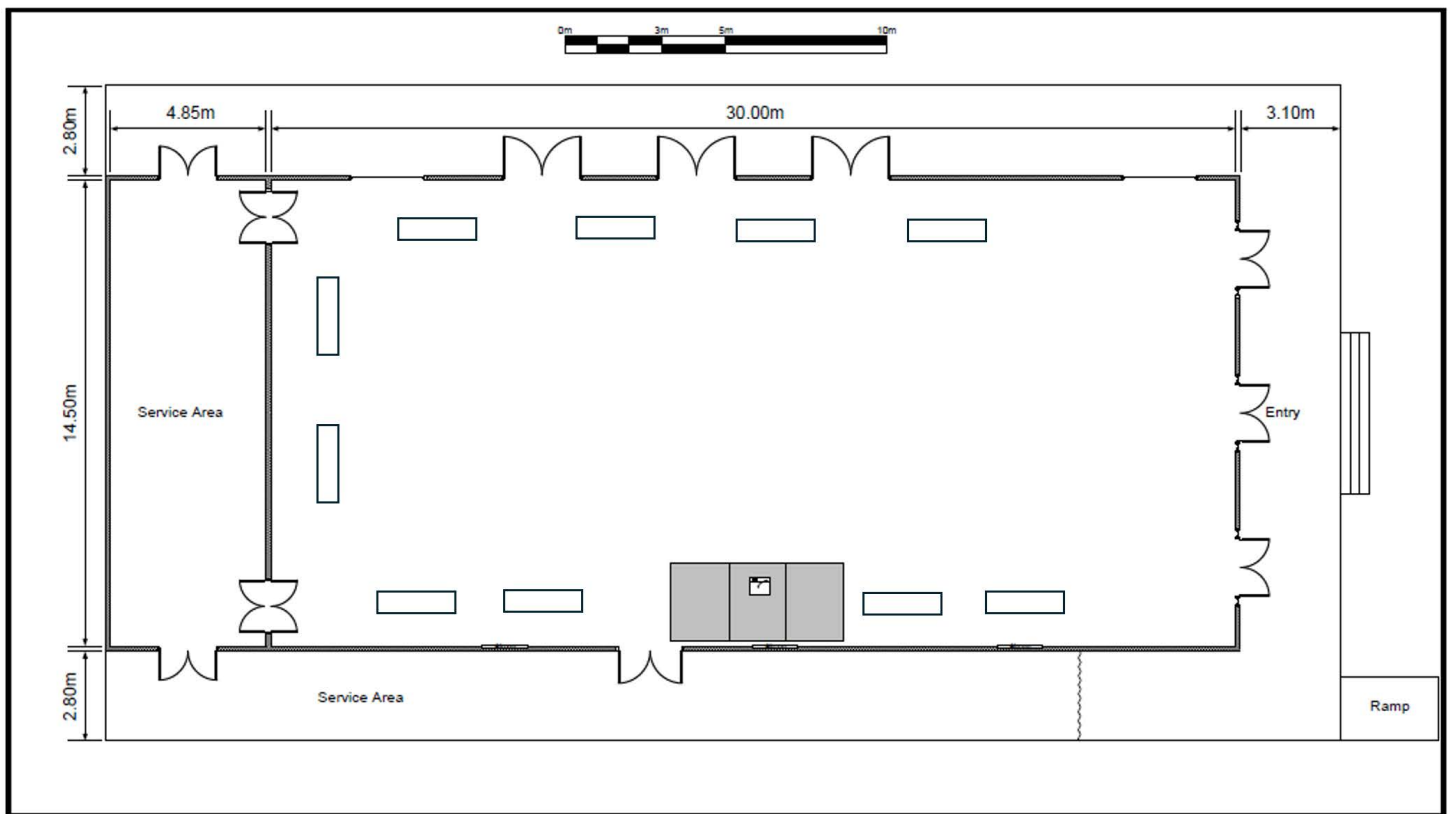
Venue information
