Overall requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Original research or audit in the area of anaesthesia, perioperative medicine or pain medicine.• Appropriate ethics approval.• Abstract submission.• Verbal presentation and question session.• All presenters must register to attend the meeting.• Open to fellows, trainees and junior doctors.
Abstract requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Maximum 400 words.• Please include introduction, aims, methods, ethics approval details, results, conclusions and references.• Must contain sufficient detail for evaluation.
Abstract submission	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 5pm Friday 2 February 2024.• Electronic submission to nlockwood@anzca.edu.au
Poster form and delivery	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Maximum size of poster 1m x 1m.• Exact date, time and location TBA.
Presentation	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Saturday 2 March 2024 During the lunch-break
Presentation requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Maximum 5 minutes and 4 slides[#].• Summary of information contained on the poster.• Response to questions from the panel and audience.
Assessor panel	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• At least three members approved by the ASA Tas state chair.
Prize	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Awarded by the ASA to the best overall poster in terms of originality, scientific rigour and quality of presentation.*
