### VIRTUAL PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

Presenters will be allocated a session time for their presentation. A maximum of 10 slides is allowed for each presentation which must include one slide on specific issues to discuss.

To allow for adequate discussion time to address protocol development and feasibility, presenters will need to allocate no more than 60% of your allocated session time to present the proposal, with the remaining time reserved for discussion with colleagues present on the online forum.

The chair of the session will provide further guidance ahead of the meeting.
