Please bring this safety alert to the attention of all who need to be aware of it.

Link advises that not all connector systems are directly compatible with ADRENALINE-LINK pre-filled syringes (PFS).

Reports of blocked syringe bores have been received by the Therapeutic Goods Administration (TGA) and Link, which made it difficult or impossible to administer a dose of potentially life-saving medication. The use of incompatible connectors (and adaptors where required) may be a contributing factor to blocked syringes.

To ensure patient safety, Link is issuing this Safety Notice to ensure all users of ADRENALINE-LINK PFS product are aware of the connector compatibility issue.

The packaging of ADRENALINE-LINK PFS product has also been updated to include a warning statement alerting users that a compatible connector is required. A list of compatible connectors and adaptors is printed overleaf and is included in the leaflet with the product.

Note: Not all stock currently in supply will have this new labelling and warning statement. Please refer to the current stock you have and if these warnings are not on the current stock please make sure that all users of this product are aware of this Safety Notice.





ADRENALINE-LINK INJECTION BP [adrenaline (epinephrine) acid tartrate] MINIMUM PRODUCT INFORMATION **INDICATION:** 1:1,000 - emergency treatment of acute severe anaphylactic reactions due to insect bites, drugs and other allergens; symptomatic relief of respiratory distress due to bronchospasm. 1:10,000 - adjunct in the management of cardiac arrest. **CONTRAINDICATIONS:** sympathomimetic amines hypersensitivity; shock (excl. anaphylactic); cardiac dilatation; coronary insufficiency; hypertension; ischaemic heart disease; arrhythmias; cerebral arteriosclerosis; diabetes mellitus; hyperthyroidism; narrow angle glaucoma; organic brain damage; phaeochromocytoma; during general anaesthesia with halogenated hydrocarbons or cyclopropane; local anaesthesia in fingers, toes, ears, nose, genitalia; labour; conditions where vasopressor drugs may be contraindicated e.g. thyrotoxicosis; obstetrics when maternal BP >130/80 mmHg.
